

**SALFORD TOWNSHIP
ROAD REPORT
FEBRUARY 2010**

The following items were addressed and completed in **FEBRUARY**:

I. EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE:

- Installed new cutting edges on snow plows for Ford F550, Sterling 7500, and John Deere 410J.
- Replaced hydraulic hose on 570 Grader.

II. WINTER STORMS and ROAD MAINTENANCE:

- Three (3) major snow storms (blizzard conditions) and numerous small icing situations in February which required extensive plowing and anti-skid to be applied on roads. Trucks were cleaned, lubricated and re-loaded in preparation for the next storm.
- Continually monitoring shoulders and intersection for site clearance - plowing and pushing back where necessary.
- Repaired and installed new road signs
- Took down trees and cleaned brush
- Mixed and store salt delivery

III. OFFICE/SHOP MAINTENANCE

- Plumbing repairs - new well tank installed in garage.
- Miscellaneous shop cleaning and maintenance.

IV. WHITE'S MILL

- Trash removal - usual pickup
