

**SALFORD TOWNSHIP
ROAD REPORT
JANUARY 2010**

The following items were addressed and completed in **JANUARY**:

I. EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE:

- Preventative service maintenance on John Deere 570 Grader
- Miscellaneous repairs on Sterling and salt spreaders
- Spot painted Mack truck to prevent rust
- Installed cutting edge on snow plows

II. WINTER STORMS and ROAD MAINTENANCE:

- Four snow storms in January which required plowing and anti-skid to be applied on roads. Trucks were cleaned, lubricated and re-loaded in preparation for the next storm.
- Heavy rain and wind storm required extensive brush and debris cleanup.
- Applied crack seal with tar kettle on paved roads, graded dirt roads and spread 2A modified aggregate for pot hole repairs.
- Checked roads, cleaned pipes and ditches to maintain water flow.
- Assisted Arrow Tree Service with removal of ten trees on Township Line Road in preparation for summer paving.
- Met with contractors to discuss upcoming paving season.

III. OFFICE/SHOP MAINTENANCE

- Re-organized office at maintenance building.
- Built earthen berm to deter trespassing on Township property.
- Miscellaneous shop cleaning and maintenance.
