April 24th 2009

Discussion re: BCM progress on complete system design and Sewer/Water Advisory Board inclusion/participation in BCM meetings. Concern re: lack of communication between Mr. Lodge's "work" on the project & SWAB. Recommendation to be carried to next BOS meeting, giving direction to Mr. Lodge to notify SWAB in advance of meetings scheduled with BCM and/or contractors noting date/time/location of meeting and proposed agenda. This will allow SWAB members the opportunity to participate if there is interest and the topic warrants.

Discussion regarding capacity in current design. It was noted that several residents have inquired as to available capacity for future growth/development per zoning, of properties included in the sewer district. BCM has not provided any information explaining how Capacity was derived. This is something that the Board felt would be a useful tool and future reference point.

Continued discussion regarding mandatory vs. non-mandatory hookup. Recommendation to be carried forward to next BOS meeting: consideration be given to allowing homes with working septic systems to defer hookup to public sewer until either the home is sold, or failure of on-lot septic system. Note that "working systems" will need to be detailed by BOS.
