ORDINANCE NO. **29**

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING REGULATIONS AND RESTRICTIONS
FOR OUTDOOR FIRES WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF SALFORD,
AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

The BOARD OF SUPERVISORS of the TOWNSHIP OF SALFORD hereby
ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. No person or persons shall set or maintain any
fire upon any of the streets, sidewalks, alleys, or public grounds in
the Township of Salford, or burn or cause to be burned thereon any
paper, boxes, rubbish, leaves, or other material or substance of any
kind.

SECTION 2. Out-of-door fires shall be permitted, upon private
property provided that the following regulations and restrictions are
strictly adhered to: No fire shall be closer than fifty feet (50') from
any building or from any property line unless the fire shall be built in
and confined to a non-combustible container, covered with a screen of one-
half inch (~") or smaller mesh in which case the fire shall be no closer
than fifteen feet (15') from any building or from any property line. No
such fire shall be allowed to burn upon any
day, except between the hours of sunrise and seven o'clock p.m.

SECTION 3. The Chief of the Tylersport Volunteer Fire Company
shall have full power to enforce all provisions of this ordinance. to make
inspection, to bring complaints against any person or firm not complying
with the provisions of this ordinance, and also to declare a state of
emergency as a result of dryness or some other serious fire hazard, during
which period all outdoor fires shall be prohibited; provided that nothing
contained herein shall prevent any officer of Salford Township from
proceeding with enforcement of the provisions hereof.

SECTION 4. Any person who shall violate or fail to conform to
any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof,
be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than twenty dollars (\$20.00) and
costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such fine and
costs, to imprisonment for not more than ten (10) days.
